



\$1,000 and \$500 Scholarships for Catholic Undergraduate Science Students




Deadline to apply: November 1, 2024

- The 2024 Gold Mass will be celebrated at St. Mark's Parish at UBC on November 20, 2024 at 12:10pm. All are invited to attend.


